

WOOSTER SOCCER CAMP - RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rules are set to help with the safety and security of each camper. Rules also help provide a more enjoyable camp experience for all.

1. **Cell Phones.** Cell phones must be turned off and not used or checked during camp meetings, training sessions, games, or evening activities.

Dorms:

2. Keep your dorm room locked when you are not in the room. Always have your room key with you.
3. Do not move any furniture in your room or attempt to bunk any beds.
4. Do not remove screens from windows - windows should be locked when you are out on the field.
5. Do not climb in/out of dorm windows. Do not throw anything out of windows!
6. **Do not touch the fire extinguishers or fire alarms (unless there is a true emergency).**
7. Do not damage or deface anything on campus. You will be charged for any damages.
8. You are not allowed in other camper's rooms without their permission.
9. Campers are allowed in the dorm's lounge areas. However, pick up your trash when you leave the area.
10. Campers need to keep bathrooms clean. Always turn off the shower when finished and flush the toilets.
11. Soccer shoes must be removed at the door of dorm. No horseplay or bouncing soccer balls in dorms.
12. Campers should keep their rooms neat and clean for periodic inspections.
13. Only Wooster Soccer Camp staff, its campers, their families, and College of Wooster personnel are permitted in the dorm. Campers should not let anyone into the dorm.
14. Campers should not prop exterior dorm doors open.

Respect Others:

15. Treat everyone with respect including all camp staff, trainers, college campus personnel, and other campers.

Proper Conduct:

16. Campers are required to go to all camp sessions, meals, and evening activities.
17. Lights Out is 11:00 pm. You should have washed up and brushed your teeth. No phone calls or texting after 11:00 pm. **Please be quiet and go to sleep.**
18. When you hear the wake up call, get up, make sure your roommate is up. **Everyone** must go to breakfast each morning.
19. If you get sick or become injured, you should tell your coach, counselor on your floor in dorm, or athletic trainer.
20. Proper conduct is expected in the dining hall. No running, keep quiet, take only the food that you can eat. You can always go back for seconds. Do not remove food from the cafeteria.
21. Campers are not allowed in any other dorms besides our soccer camp dorm(s). Be in your own room during rest period.
22. Campers are required to stay within the boundaries of our camp (which will be identified the first day of camp). Campers should never walk alone. Campers should always be with at least one other camper or staff member. No-one is allowed off campus without the permission of the Camp Director.

Breaking any of these rules or any other behavior (including illegal acts) that are not covered in the above rules but which are considered detrimental to the camp, the dorm, the campus, another campers or staff members of the Wooster Soccer Camp or the College of Wooster may result in the camper being sent home at any time of the day or night.
